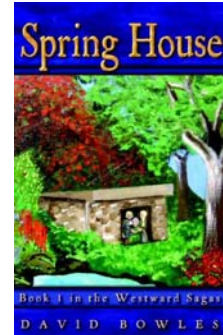
The catalog gives details on each publication including order information. ISFHWE will not take orders for the publications, but provides this catalog to facilitate the opportunity to purchase these books.
